

Transportation

Parking

The discounted rate to park at the Curtis Hotel is \$20/day, please see the front desk for this discounted rate. There are also various parking lots and structures near the hotel in the downtown area. Prices and availability for long-term parking will vary. <u>The Performing Arts Complex lot</u> across the street from the Curtis Hotel is \$21/day.

Ridesharing from DIA The cost for an Uber or Lyft to downtown Denver from DIA is roughly \$40 -\$60, depending on the time of day and traffic. Pick-up is from ride-sharingspecific areas on the floor 5 passenger pick-up area, the same floor as baggage claim. The app will tell you which specific zone to go to. Taxis are available at the airport on floor 5, but much more expensive.

RTD Lightrail to Union Station

The \$10 one-way fare on the RTD "A line" from DIA to Union Station is a convenient way to get directly downtown from the airport or vice versa. The RTD station at DIA is located near the entrance to the South TSA checkpoint. From Union Station, it is a 0.6-mile walk to the Curtis Hotel. The free RTD MallRide buses are a good way to get closer to the hotel, more info on that is below. if you want a ride, it's approximately 5 minutes and \$7-10 for a rideshare.

The RTD MallRide is a good way to get around downtown. It's normal route is along 16th St, but due to ongoing construction it is subject to reroutes, so please check the <u>RTD website</u> for the most up-to-date information in November.
